Rep. Sloan Files for Re-Election

Rep. Tom Sloan filed as a candidate for re-election to the Kansas House of Representatives' 45th District. Sloan is seeking his 11th term representing residents in western Lawrence neighborhoods and the western Douglas County Townships.

"My experience, knowledge, and leadership on water, energy, agriculture, and education issues benefit Lawrence and Douglas County residents," Sloan said. "During these challenging economic and political times, my common sense leadership ensures that Douglas County residents' voices are heard and considered at the State Capitol and nationally."

During his legislative service, Sloan has served as Chairman of the Vision 2020 and Higher Education Committees; Vice Chairman of the Utilities Committee; and a member of the Agriculture, Local Government, Vision 2000, Transportation, and Technology Committees. He also has served as Co-Chairman of the Council of State Governments' (CSG) Interstate Electric Transmission Siting Compact Task Force and Energy Committee; and as a member of the Department of Energy's (DOE) Electricity Advisory Committee and GridWise Architecture Council; Federal Communications Commission's (FCC) Intergovernmental Advisory Committee; and National Conference of State Legislatures' (NCSL) Energy Supply and Military & Veterans Task Forces. He also was on the Executive Committee of the National Wind Coordinating Council (NWCC). Sloan has organized 15 energy, telecommunications, water, and healthcare Policy Summits that brought federal, regional, and state policy-makers to Lawrence to coordinate planning and strategies.
